

Fishery Rules on main lake, pond and river

Barbless hooks only.

Unhooking mat compulsory for unhooking larger fish.

No Keepnets.

Landing nets should be thoroughly dried before fishing to help prevent the risk of the spread of disease.

Maximum line strength on Main lake and pond 5lb.

Maximum hook size 12 barbless on Main lake and pond. 14, 16 or 18 will be more than sufficient.

No Fires or Barbeques

Noise should be kept to a minimum. No music. No excessive alcohol.

All litter to be removed from fishery.

EA rod licence is required.

No movement of fish between waters. The main lake is part of the **National Crucian Conservation Project**.

Please retain and notify Gary if any Crucian or (Tench over 2lb) are caught in the pond.

No dogs allowed in the main lake area inside of the otter fencing and must be kept on a lead in all other areas around the farm excluding holiday let gardens. Please remove dog waste.

No night fishing on main lake or river.

No guests or spectators in main lake area, unless agreed with Gary. We have other day ticket anglers. Experienced anglers only. U16's to be accompanied by a adult or again agreed with Gary.

Please speak to Gary before fishing the main lake.

If any of the above is not adhered to you will be asked to leave the fishery.
